Excavation Team Trading Cards

In this activity your class will apply knowledge gained after watching the videos of the excavation team experts.

Your class has been learning about the different experts who participate in an excavation. These experts are:

Leadership Grid Supervisor Square supervisor Microarchaeolgist Survey Photography Registrar Volunteer

Class Set of Trading Cards:

Have each student pick one of these experts and make a trading card with a picture of the expert on one side and their "stats" on the other. Stats include:

- 1. Listing the name of the expert
- 2. Documenting how they help on the excavation.
- 3. Listing the tools the expert uses.

After drawing and writing students can cut the cards out and then glue the 2 halves together. Students can then put the trading cards on a ring to keep them all together.

Consider making a class book of trading cards. Enlarge the trading card on a copy machine. After students finish making the cards bind them into a book for your classroom library.

Individual Set of Trading Cards:

Copy enough trading cards for each student to make their own set of trading cards. They will each draw a picture of each expert and list their stats on the other side. Stats include:

- 1. Listing the name of the expert
- 2. Documenting how they help on the excavation.
- 3. Listing the tools the expert uses.

After drawing and writing students can cut the cards out and then glue the 2 halves together. Students can then put the trading cards on a ring to keep them all together.
